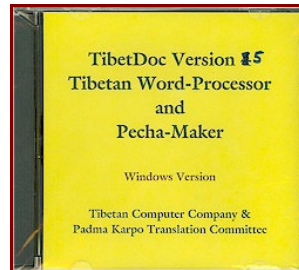


TIBETDOC WORDPROCESSOR and PECHA MAKER Version 5

TibetDoc V.5 is the most powerful Tibetan word-processing program available. It contains all the specialized features needed for serious Tibetan text production and preservation yet perfectly provides for the needs of the beginning language student, too.



TibetDoc has the most advanced yet simple pecha-production system available. Press a button and all of the current document turns into pecha. Alternatively, just turn on pecha and start typing directly into a pecha! Another button gives total control over the pecha style and format. Pecha styles are totally authentic. Production is easy for pure Tibetan text and equally easy for mixed Tibetan / transliteration / translation for Western student's practice materials. *TibetDoc* supports English, all European, Baltic, Greek, and Russian languages, too.

TibetDoc has the special feature that you can click on any Tibetan word and immediately look it up in any of our several Tibetan-English and Tibetan-Tibetan dictionaries (you must have purchased them first; look for *The Illuminator Tibetan-English Dictionary*, the *Sarat Chandra Das Tibetan-English Dictionary* and the *Geshe Chodrak Tibetan-Tibetan Dictionary* which are all available from the *Tibetan Language Institute*). You can also copy and paste from the dictionaries directly into TibetDoc so that you can make your own glossaries or notes.

The program also has all the standard features of a word processor but with all the special features needed for dealing with Tibetan and transliterated Sanskrit, too. It has true Tibetan keyboards and a Wylie keyboard, too. It has Wylie and ACIP to Tibetan converters (gives access to texts from a wide range of sources, including the whole ACIP range). Tibetan spelling checker included. Export to RTF, Word, and WordPerfect. Complete on-line documentation, keyboard maps, etc. Import feature allows access to the hundreds of volumes of texts available in

monasteries in Asia that have been typed in the Tibetan 5 for DOS format (these texts are available from the various monasteries e.g., such as Shechen Monastery in Kathmandu, on request).

Contains TibetDoc version 5 software for Windows
(Runs properly on the Mac's Windows emulator).

CD comes with the standard Tibetan typeface called Tibetan Machine.

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
